



Hide Relaxer

This is a highly active rehydrator that works 2-3 times faster than other rehydrators, which helps lessen the chance of bacteria growth. A quality bactericide/fungicide should be used in conjunction with **Hide Relaxer**

Bring product to room temperature and mix well. Wear splash proof goggles, and disposable rubber gloves to prevent any eye or skin irritation.

Stable in the presence of electrolytes.

Activity: 70-73%

pH: Approx. 6

Recommended use:

Rehydration: Use $\frac{1}{4}$ to 1 ounce of **Hide Relaxer** per gallon of solution. The actual amount used will be based on water volume, thickness and density of the hide. It is recommended to also add $\frac{3}{4}$ lb salt for every 10 gallons solutions, to prevent any swelling.

For Difficult to Rehydrate Skins: Add 1 part **Hide Relaxer** to 2 parts water and brush on flesh side. It may take several applications. When the hide starts to relax, roll up for several hours or until relaxed enough to place in rehydration solution.

For Grease Burned Skins: Mix 2 parts **Hide Relaxer** with 1 part acetone. **Note:** This should be done in an unheated and well ventilated area, with no open flame and no smoking. Brush a heavy application of the mixture to the flesh side and fold up overnight. Several applications may be necessary. Once relaxed, place the hide in a pickle solution with **Degreaser SD** in order to out pull out fat. See separate directions for this product.

Simplified ratios for hard-dried and difficult skins to rehydrate:

Deer, bear, medium elk skins: $\frac{3}{4}$ cups to 70 gallons of water.

Large elk, medium African skins: 4-6 cups to 70 gallons of water.

Large African skins: 6-8 cups to 70 gallons of water.

Note: Do not place a hide in hot water. This can loosen the hair and cause bacteria growth.



Precautionary Statements: Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.

Hazard statements: Causes eye irritation and may irritate skin causing dryness. *If in Eyes:* Rinse with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. *If on Skin and Clothing:* Wash skin immediately with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing. If skin or eye irritation persists, get medical attention. Store product closed in original container in a cool, dry area. Keep out of the reach of children.
